Wax polish

Product features

Wax Polish is a solvent-containing, liquid wax mixture intended for the treatment of lacquered parquet. It is particularly suited for initial treatment immediately after parquet installation, since it provides effective edge protection. Wax Polish is used undiluted – do not add it to mopping water!

Working with the product

- Vacuum-clean the parquet floor and then clean it with a cleaning device (e.g. Bauwerk cleaning mop) to create a damp surface (e.g. adding Bauwerk Parquet Cleaner to the mopping water), and then let it dry.
- Shake Wax Polish well before use.
- Apply it in a thin layer with a cloth or a sponge, rub it in with a single-disk machine, and let dry for about 20 minutes. Then polish the floor with a dry cloth or using a white polishing pad on your single-disk machine.
- If the parquet was lacquered with a solvent-containing PU lacquer on-site, the initial treatment should take place only approx. 15 days after the lacquering (once the lacquer has completely cured).

Storage

- May be stored for at least 1 year in well-sealed original packaging
- Keep away from children
- Do not store at temperatures under 5 °C

- Contains alkanes
